This cache wants to show you the bridge and the impressive canyon.

At the coordinates you can park your car. At the right side of the entrance to the funiculaire you find a narrow passing to reach the trail. Go to the first point and find a number (M _ _ Bergbahnen). A

From there you follow the trail to the stage 2, whre you need the depth of the canyon. B

Now pass the wunderful bridge and walk up the village. At point 3 you look for a red-framed number. C

Passing the apiary you walk down to the small bridge. On the other side there is a tiny wooden cottage. Go there and count the horizontal boards of its door, the small one too. D

That is all, now you make the account and look for the box at N 47 08.X E 011 48.Y

$$X = 9 * (A + B + C + D) + B + C$$

 $Y = 8 * (A + B + C + D) + C$

The GPS is dancing around here, therefor you get a little hint. Please lock again all of the four brackets of the box!
